

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Hi Mike

I have managed to find some pictures of the 1200's

Firstly, how we would have done it if the lever had been from the primary cover (engine casing) - it could still be done that way if you put this style of lever on.





Secondly how it would need to be done using the 'forward sets' that are fitted currently.







A 'Kuryakyn Magnum Quick Clamp' of the appropriate size for the frame downtube will give a support for our swivel clamp. You will see that in order to achieve the correct angle (90 Degrees) and length of stroke (1") we have bolted an additional lever to the original.

We would also suggest the Bluespot High Power unit for this gearbox as it is quite heavy.
